
Standing Order No. 10

Attorneys are permitted to use electronic equipment, such as cellular telephones, pagers, and laptop computers, in the courthouses within the district. However, cellular telephones and pagers must be turned off while in the courtrooms. Cellular telephones are not permitted in the grand jury rooms while the grand jury is in session. The use of a laptop computer should not be disruptive to court proceedings. Each judicial officer may modify this rule as the circumstances warrant.


