AMENDED STANDING ORDER NO. 2

When a district judge determines it appropriate to assign cases to a magistrate judge, the assignment shall be as follows:


1. All Wheeling point of holding court cases shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge James E. Seibert.
2. All Clarksburg point of holding court cases shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge John S. Kaull.
3. All civil actions at the Martinsburg point of holding court cases shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge Seibert. Beginning October 9, 2001, all newly filed odd numbered criminal actions shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge David J. Joel and all even numbered criminal actions shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge Seibert until December 31, 2001. Beginning January 1, 2002, all newly filed Martinsburg criminal actions shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge Joel.
4. All Elkins point of holding court cases shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge Kaull.
5. If conflicts or unusual circumstances arise with respect to any civil or criminal matter assigned to any magistrate judge, the (magistrate or district) judges, upon consultation and conference will determine the appropriate magistrate judge's docket upon which the matter should be placed and the Clerk's Office will be advised


accordingly.


