**ORDER REGARDING ACCESS TO PROCEEDINGS
BY ZOOM VIDEOCONFERENCE/TELECONFERENCE**

This matter is scheduled for a Preliminary Hearing and Detention Hearing on Monday, March 22, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. at the Clarksburg, West Virginia point of holding court. Currently, federal, state, county, and local public health authorities continue to advise public and private agencies to take necessary and appropriate precautions to reduce the possibility of exposure to COVID-19 and slow the spread of the disease. This matter is of significant public interest.

For reasons appearing to the Court, and to provide a platform by which members of the public may safely view or listen to the proceedings on March 22, 2021, these proceedings will be accessible by Zoom videoconferencing/teleconferencing. The public may access the proceedings as follows:

The authorization of remote access to the Preliminary Hearing and Detention Hearing via Zoom videoconference or teleconference is limited and does not authorize more traditional forms of “broadcasting” court proceedings, such as livestreaming court hearings on the internet. Persons granted access to the proceedings are reminded of the general prohibition against photographing, recording, and rebroadcasting of court proceedings. A violation of these prohibitions may result in sanctions, including removal of court issued media credentials, restricted entry to future hearings, denial of entry to future hearings, and any other sanctions deemed necessary by the Court.
